

The OSADL Base Image

How to get started



1. Unpack the archive [*Variant-Arch-Release*]-[...].tgz of the desired version (*binary-delivery* or *src-delivery*).
2. Contained within is the Docker Base Image *osadl-[distro]-docker-base-image-[...].tar*, the legal information (*legal-info-[...].txt*) and for the binary delivery version also the material for the delayed source code delivery [*Variant*]-*src.tgz* that contains source code, build instructions and the license scan. For the source code delivery version this archive is delivered inside the container image.
3. Install the Docker engine as described in <https://docs.docker.com/engine/install/> (or compatible alternatives, e.g. Podman <https://podman.io/>).
4. Load the OSADL Base Image:

```
# docker load < osadl-[distro]-docker-base-image-[...].tar
```
5. Verify that the image was loaded and obtain its REPOSITORY/IMAGE and TAG names:

```
# docker image ls
```
6. Run the container:

```
# docker run -it IMAGE:TAG /bin/bash
```
7. To customize the container image either install additional packages through the package management of the base image or add additional layers on top of the base image via Dockerfile.
