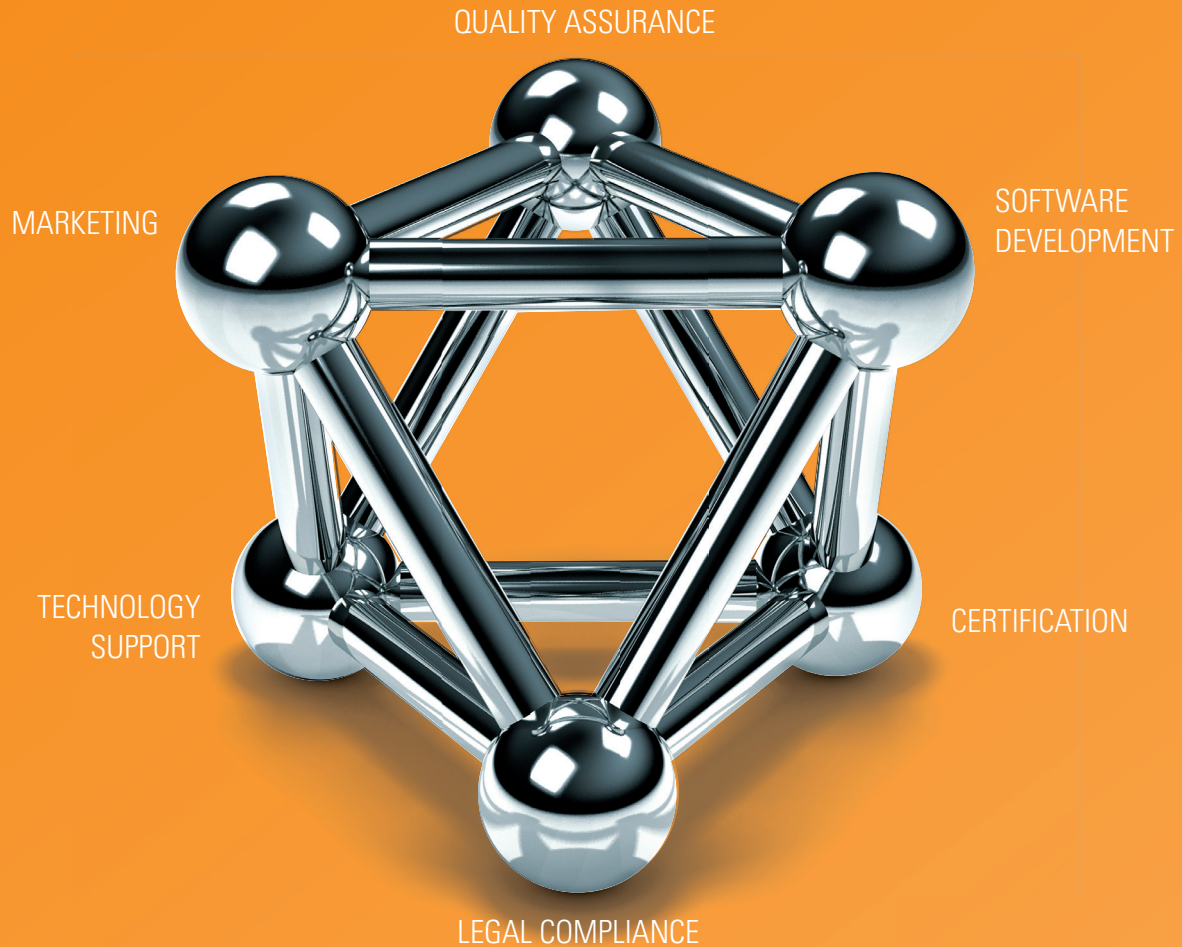
## What is OSADL?
